**Karaktär** Komplex doft med inslag av mogna röda bär, hallon, blommor, plommon, choklad, örter, kryddor och tobak. Smaken är fyllig med en välbalanserad syra och sammetslena tanniner. Lång, elegant eftersmak med en fin mineralitet.

**Tillverkning** Druvorna skördades för hand. De avstjälkades innan de pressades skonsamt och musten fick sedan jäsa i 2-3 veckor med skalkontakt i ståltank. Malolaktisk jäsning skedde långsamt i barriquer fram till senvåren. Vinet har legat över ett år på sin egen jästfällning utan omrörning. Vinet har lagrats ungefär 30 månader i stora slavonska ekfat. Vinet är ofiltrerat.

**Passar till** Serveras vid 16-18°C till rätter av lamm, nöt eller vilt, gärna med inslag av svamp.

Drink Date: 2027 - 2055 You could argue that this is the wine with the fasting growing quality trajectory because this vineyard site is one of those rare places in the appellation that appears to improve despite (or more likely because of) a changing climate. Ravera enjoys an open panorama (at 400 to 440 meters in elevation) that extends to the snow-capped Alps and benefits from cooler air currents, coupled with an amazing quality of light that you notice with the naked eye. The 2021 Barolo Ravera saw its fruit harvested later than the other wines, on October 11th, and continued with a classic Vietti-style fermentation with 20-plus days of skin contact. Simply put, what Ravera offers is complexity (and strength) with hints of bergamot, citrus, herbs, mineral and salt over a tightly concentrated mouthfeel. The quality of the tannins and the freshness of this 2021 are impressive, and that citrusy note continues with tangerine skin and kumquat.

### Jancis Robinson 17p

Novello. Lustrous mid ruby. Cool crushed-raspberry nose which becomes more concentrated and perfumed with aeration. Real development in the glass. Much more backward on the palate with slowly unfurling, perfumed red fruit on a thick layer of sandy tannins and supple acidity. Still a little embryonic. Drink date : 2028-2040

### Wine Spectator 96p

Macerated cherry, raspberry, plum, hay and iron flavors converge in this rich, muscular red. Its tannins are dense yet civilized, with flashes of green tea and earth on the extended aftertaste. This is expressive today yet will be better in three to five years. Best from 2028 through 2047.
